## EAST LIMERICK CHILDREN'S SERVICES UPDATE

• East Limerick Children Services is operated by Avista in partnership with the HSE. We currently (30.09.2024) have **989** children accepted to our service. **764** children active. **225** children are currently on the waiting list. Approximate waiting time for start of service provision: **24** plus months

#### **ACTIVITIES AND UPDATES REGIONAL**

#### **Regional CDNT's:**

- Improving Communications: regional questionnaire was completed by over 1200 people/report with themes finalised and under review – implication on practice; communication with families: main topic
- Development of service information leaflet regionally; launch by end of year
- IFSP leaflet and information now available
- Signposting to other support services now available/website

# ACTIVITIES AND UPDATES EAST LIMERICK CHILDREN SERVICES

- Planning to resume in person service introduction meetings
- Working on improving Avista website/awaiting funding allocation for interactive access including courses and webinars (Limerick and Dublin CDNT's)
- We are planning to introduce quarterly newsletter: what topics would you like to hear about?
- Back yard had to be cleared due to unfit equipment and fencing plan to create a safe outdoor space for all including sensory spaces: in preparation, cladding to be installed before Christmas; proposal for funding in preparation (incl soft flooring, sensory wall, seating, equipment shed)

#### **ACTIVITIES AND UPDATES**

- Inclusive summer camp at University of Limerick in collaboration with Limerick and Clare Sports Partnership: will continue next year with same
- Whole team training on "Being Me parent and children neuroaffirmative group" rollout from end of October this year
- Responsive feeding training today and tomorrow in Dublin: to be rolled out at ELCS



#### **CURRENT CHALLENGES**

- Ongoing staff vacancies impact on capacity and waiting times for entry to services
- High number of children to clinician ratio- burnout of staff
- Non replacement of maternity leaves
- Issues not actioned to move services forward for example casting services at CDNT's
- HSE Disabilities office closed at present business cases not being dealt with/delays
