MEET YOUR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPISTS

We have one full-time and one parttime occupational therapists-Lisa & Kate B. Occupational therapists (OTs) work with children in various settings, including clinical, school environments, and the home. OTs look at a child's functional strengths & areas of difficulty across different performance areas including activities of daily living, school, play and leisure and assist with strategies to promote independence, participation and quality of life. Occupational therapy helps children build essential life skills and enhance their overall well-being and participation in their daily activities.

USEFUL TIPS/SUGGESTIONS FROM YOUR OT

A tip for learning to a new skill such as dressing, buttons, zips or shoelaces. Try the backward chaining method. This involves breaking down the task into small achievable steps, always ensuring your young person achieves success.
